

Sanchez de Carmona

Note: The first part of this family history was published in September, 2002, Vol. 11, no. 3.

At the end of the XVII century, arriving from the city of Cordoba, in Andalucia, this family established itself in Santiago de Cuba.

Don Blas Sanchez, and his wife doña Jeronima de Carmona were the parents of:

Captain Alonso Sanchez de Carmona, native of the city of Cordoba, married in the Cathedral of Santiago de Cuba, June 29, 1690, doña Maria Ramos y Vazquez Valdes de Coronado y Cisneros, daughter of the Captain Francisco Ramos, and of doña Graciana Vazquez Valdes de Coronado y Cisneros. (One sister of Maria; Dorotea Ramos Vazquez Valdes de Coronado married don Esteban Lorenzo Palacios-Saldurtun y Betancourt). They were the parents of: Barbara, and of Francisco Xavier Sanchez de Carmona y Ramos. Of these:

1.- Doña Barbara Sanchez de Carmona y Ramos, married in the Cathedral of Santiago de Cuba, April 24, 1715, don Jose Ramos y Ferrer, Chief Ensign and Mayor, son of the Sargent Mayor don Juan Ramos, and of doña Maria Teresa Ferrer y Roxas. (One brother of Maria Teresa Ferrer y Roxas; don Vicente Ferrer y Roxas, married in the Cathedral of Santiago de Cuba, December 30, 1714 doña Isabel Maria Cisneros y Machado).

2.- Don Francisco Xavier Sanchez de Carmona y Ramos, baptized in the Cathedral of Santiago de Cuba, March 16, 1702 was Chief Constable of the Holy Office of the Inquisition. Was also Mayor de Santiago de Cuba in 1732 and in 1766 married in the Cathedral of Santiago de Cuba, April 12, 1723 doña Rafaela Caballero y de la Cova, daughter of the Captain Antonio Caballero, Alferez Mayor, and of doña Maria Ana de la Cova y Luna. They were the parents of Pedro; Domingo, and of Francisco Xavier Sanchez de Carmona y Caballero. Of these:

2.A.- . Don Pedro Sanchez de Carmona y Caballero, will be treated in the “First Branch”. (This branch was published in REVISTA, September 2002, Vol 11 No. 3.)

2.B.- Don Domingo Sanchez de Carmona y Caballero, will be treated in the “Second Branch” below.

2.C.- Don Francisco Xavier Sanchez de Carmona y Caballero, will be treated in the “Third Branch” below.

“Second Branch”

2.B.- Don Domingo Sanchez de Carmona y Caballero (mentioned before as son of don Francisco Xavier Sanchez de Carmona y Ramos, and of doña Rafaela Caballero y de la Cova), was Colonel Lieutenant of Militias in the Plaza de Santiago de Cuba.
